She also found a museum featuring a private collection of Florida art in Daytona.




















STERLING SILVER CASTING

On December 10-12, John Catana taught a Silver Casting Class at the Cape Canaveral Shop. This class is using the Lost Wax Process.






The first step is creating or selecting models.



Robert is creating models from a shark tooth and a ring. Michelle is making models from wax for mounting cabochons. Elizabeth selected premade wax models that will be used in silversmithing and the Southwest Jewelry Class.







The models are attached to a base and placed within a flask that will be filled with investment, a plaster like material.

After the investment dries overnight, the flask will be placed in the kiln and heated to 1200 °F as the wax burns out and the mold cures.


Scrap silver is being melted to remove impurities before being used in casting.



The kiln (left) and the interior of the casting apparatus (below). John and Robert are melting the silver using a torch. When the silver is liquified, the pin will be released and the silver will enter the mold.

Next the pieces will be separated and cleaned and polished.

Below left are Robert's finished pieces.



Below right are Elizabeth's. The two pieces in the bottom right corner are from the base and the sprue which are scrap and will be used in future projects. The feathers, leaves, arrowhead, and small blossom will be used in the Southwest Jewelry Class.

Club Purpose:


The purpose of this club is to foster interest in and to promote knowledge and appreciation of minerals, gems, fossils, and the earth sciences.


