Meeting opened with pledge of allegiance at 6:10 pm. **Minutes** waived.

Treasurer's report given by Michele. Our expenses were higher than our income due to the effect of the pandemic.

Membership report given by Lucy. We have 64 members, 3 youth, 5 life.

Workshop has been open since May although with limited days....Sunday afternoons from 1-4pm, Wednesdays from 9:30-12:30 and 1-4pm. Classes have been limited to 1:1 instruction in the classroom and number of club members attending have been limited to 6 plus 2 supervisors. John and Pete have checked all machines and they are all in working order. John was able to set up an intarsia machine as well.

Classes: At this time, we are ready to increase class size to 3 members and utilize Tuesday evenings for silversmith (beginner and advanced), silversmith beginner either Wednesday or Sunday afternoons, cabbing Monday evenings, kumihimo or chainmaille Sunday or Wednesday afternoons.

Show report given by Roz. We may or may not have issues in using Kiwanis island gymnasium as our usual location. Apparently, new regulations for a public venue per Brevard county will not be known until December. If we cannot use the gym, we could use the outdoor pavilion. Security is available, 9 vendors so far have agreed to attend and more are being sought. We will have issues

with moving picnic tables to create individual booths and we will have to follow 6' apart, and the use of masks. Erleen and I are still investigating. To do this, we will need several able-bodied members to assist.

Newsletter has been going out by email and regular mail.

Inventory will be redone by Mario.

Following the meeting, members participated in silent auction.

We are looking for a person to help create an Ebay account to help sell off some of our surplus slabs, donated jewelry and finished items to help keep add to our funds.

Workshop update provided by Michele. Pete and John continue to keep shop running. 3 wheels replaced on Genies. Slab saw and George's saw were cleaned out and new oil replaced. A/C filter replaced and thermostat reset.

Show: We very recently received the approval from Kiwanis Parks Department allowing us to have our show in the gymnasium and annex like we usually do. We still have to observe social distancing and masks may be required. Contracts are in the process of going out to vendors who attended last year. We will need more volunteers, especially those who are able bodied to help with moving items needed to be brought to the show and returned to the workshop, as well as, setting up the electrical wire for the center vendors.
