Lucy Caracoglia finished this beautiful color change faceted stone pendant with the double bale and the free form link chain with beads.



The earrings on the left are blue Cubic Zirconia mounted in baskets and secured with prongs. They are attached to a post by a jump ring. Elizabeth completed these in John's silver class.

On the right is a plan for an opal that was polished and shaped by Elizabeth. The design includes a border and bale of filigree. This plan was designed by John Catana and will be completed in the Filigree Class that will be scheduled when more members sign up.





On the left are three pieces completed by Elizabeth in John's silver class. These pieces were in the Show and Tell section of Septembers meeting.

The Bracelet has a Granite stone and the leaves are from the casting class.

The Jade Pendant has a has a border of twisted wire.

The Boulder Opal is in a setting of scalloped bezel wire bordered by beaded wire.

Both pendants have bales on the back.

Filigree

"Filigree is a form of intricate metalwork used in jewelry and other small forms of metalwork. In jewelry, it is usually of gold and silver, made with tiny beads or twisted threads, or both in combination, soldered together or to the surface of an object of the same metal and arranged in artistic motifs.

It often suggests lace."

It was popular in Italian, French and Portuguese metalwork from 1660 to the late 19th century.

Michele will be doing a presentation on Filigree at the October meeting and sharing slides of her trip to Wildacres in North Carolina and her own creations of filigree.

John Catana will be teaching Filigree early next year. Contact Roz to join.

Club Purpose:


The purpose of this club is to foster interest in and to promote knowledge and appreciation of minerals, gems, fossils, and the earth sciences.

PROPOSED SHOP FEE INCREASES AND SCHEDULE CHANGE

The Board has decided that membership fees will remain \$30 for 2022.

A motion was made to increase class fees from \$12 to \$20 for each class session. The motion Passed the board. If supplies for classes are needed, each participant will either purchase items on their own or from the instructor.

A motion was made to raise shop fees from \$6 to \$10/session, effective January 1, 2022. This will be a revision to standing rule #4.
