Hope you all have a fun summer planned and that you will find time to travel and that you will come into the shop to create.




Workshop Report: John reported that all machines are working.

Club Purpose:


The purpose of this club is to foster interest in and to promote knowledge and appreciation of minerals, gems, fossils, and the earth sciences.
